

LMAC "TOMBOY" RULES

BACKGROUND: The "Tomboy" event has enjoyed great success primarily because of the low cost of entry and the informality of the contest. However as more people enter, it may be desirable to have something to aim for rather than just a time duration. This is particularly important if the "Tomboy" scores are counted towards the annual trophy awards. We need to do this without losing the "fun" element.

ELECTRICS: There are more electric models now justifying a separate class. However electric should be limited to one motor run (i.e. no restarts). If a restart is required (say in an emergency), the flight is disqualified.

CLASS	DIESEL	ELECTRIC
Start Countdown	2 minutes	Not required
Motor Duration	3.0cc	2 minute max (no restarts without disqualification) CD calls "Motors OFF"
Flight Duration	5 > 8 minutes depending on conditions as nominated by CD	
Flight Score	1 point for each second to duration limit	
Landing & it's effect on Total score	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plus 30 points if on the Strip Minus 30 points if landing is off the strip Zero Total score if landing is outside designated "landing zone".
